Introducing the GROWS e-platform!

200+ European trainers took part in the pilot testing

March was dedicated to the launch of the next result of our GROWS project. The e-learning platform that the consortium developed is now available, in English, Polish, Greek, Portuguese, Italian, and Bulgarian. The <u>GROWS e-learning platform</u> hosts the Intelligent Tutor for guidance on creating a green education action plan - a learning resource that makes learning more attractive and memorable for VET trainers. The Platform provides instant access to a full suite of gamified learning resources, including 21 digital lesson plans on sustainable waste management, green skills and environment, as well as OERs, and tools for transforming the VET sector. The first group of more than 200 trainers and learners from 5 partner countries had already tested the GROWS e-Learning space and had the opportunity to evaluate its contents, design, and functionality.

The GROWS Training of Trainers is coming soon!

A 3-day learning program for VET providers and trainers will be conducted in April and May! The training will take place in each partner country (Bulgaria, Poland, Portugal, Greece, Cyprus, Italy), where only 20 educators per country will have the opportunity to implement activities and design a green education action plan to raise learners' awareness about waste management.

The training is both theoretical and practical. The theoretical aspect provides knowledge about sustainable waste management practices, strategies for green transition, etc. During the practical part, participants will explore the project resources (e-learning platform, Toolkit, Digital Intelligent Tutor) and create action plans to integrate GROWS materials into their VET practices.
