Debunking fake news about climate change is not easy, and convincing others of the facts is even harder. You need to know a lot yourself, but you also need to be able to communicate and convince others of what is right.

Being a 'climate ambassador' requires certain competencies. What these are and how to convey them was the subject of the training course that took place on 14-16 February in Palermo with 20 youth workers, teachers and trainers.
